Mountain View, Frasier Meadows Retirement Community, And Boulder Community Hospital will have a CarFit Event in the church's parking lot. CarFit is an educational program that offers older adults the opportunity to check how well their personal vehicles "fit" them. A proper fit in one's car can greatly increase not only the driver's safety but also the safety of others. At a CarFit event, a team of trained technicians and/or health professionals work with each participant to ensure they "fit" their vehicle properly for maximum comfort and safety. A CarFit check takes approximately 30 minutes to complete. The CarFit program also provides information and materials

on community-specific resources that could enhance their safety as drivers, and/or increase their mobility in the community. There will be a CarFit Volunteer Training at Frasier Meadows' in the third floor Fireside Lounge. The Volunteer Training session will prepare participants to become CarFit Volunteers. It will include training for the Volunteer Check-In Greeters who will confirm appointments, ensure the drivers complete the necessary paper work and waivers. Also, the Volunteer CarFit Technicians will learn to use the CarFit 12-Point Check List with CarFit participants.
